Lion Bob Bohannon

18 June 1920 – 27 May 2003

On May 27, 2003, Lion Bob Bohannon passed away. Lion Bob was born on June 18, 1920. He married Margaret Bohannon on July 9, 1943, in Springfield, MO. He was a veteran of WWII during which time he served as an officer in the Army Corps of Engineers. After the war, he worked in general construction in El Paso, TX, for over forty years before retiring in Ruidoso. Survivors include his wife Margaret; children, Robert R. Bohannon of Dallas, TX, and Sarah E. Bohannon of Silver City, NM; three grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. Lion Bob was active in the First Presbyterian Church of El Paso (over 50 years) and the First Presbyterian Church of Ruidoso. He was a member of the Association of General Contractors of El Paso and the Woodworkers Club of El Paso.

Lion Bob joined the Club in June 1997. Since that time until recently, he had been a very active member. Lion Bob's big contribution for the Club was the wooden toys (over 200) he constructed and finished each year for the Ruidoso's Santa's Helpers project at Christmas. Prior to 1997, he provided the same service for the El Paso Toys for Tots.
